In 2011 SJF Institute will launch its new *Employees Matter: Maximizing Company Value Through Workforce Engagement* report in which we profile 24 mostly small- to medium-sized private companies that can directly correlate their high-road human resources practices and broadly shared employee ownership with increased business performance and ability to weather economic downturns.
